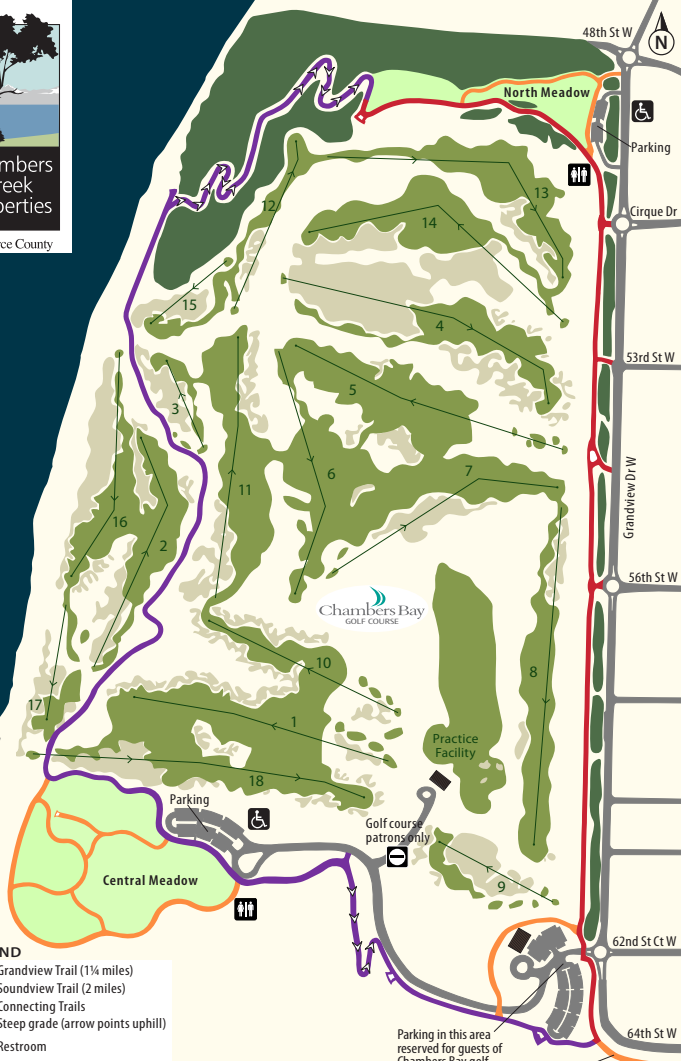

The Chambers Creek Properties are unique among public lands. Included in the 930 acres are over two miles of saltwater shoreline, two-and-a-half miles of urban creek and canyon, and breathtaking mountain and Puget Sound views. Pierce County has created a nationally recognized redevelopment plan which seeks to achieve a balance of public access, government services and revenue generation.

Currently visitors may use the playfields, walk miles of public trails, play Chambers Bay golf course, and visit the award-winning Environmental Services Building and Chambers Creek Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant. Future plans include beach access, off-leash dog areas, boat launch, restaurants, lodging, and environmental learning center. Make plans to visit us today!

The Chambers Creek Properties are open from dawn to dusk (adjusted seasonally). Portions of the site will continue to remain closed for your safety.

Visiting



Parking is available along Grandview Drive and in parking areas at Central Meadow, North Meadow, and the Environmental Services Building. The parking area at the 62nd Street entrance is reserved for guests of Chambers Bay golf course and grill.

You can take Pierce Transit to the Properties via Route 53 (University Place). The bus stop is located at the corner of Cirque Drive and Grandview Drive, across the street from Cirque Plaza.
